On June 23, 2004, Roy Glover, 38, of 4220 W. Adams was arrested by Chicago Police while selling heroin and cocaine across the street from the Goldblatt Elementary School. At the time of his arrest, Glover was in possession of a loaded automatic weapon. Glover, a member of the Gangster Disciples street gang, has previous arrests for gang murder and possession of a weapon in prison.

Glover was recently sentenced to 30 years in Federal prison after being convicted as an armed career criminal. There is no parole in the Federal system.
